• **Mass Youth & Leagues Committee**

- MYSA Night at the Revs - 9/22/18
- Appeals and Grievance procedure – Mass Youth Soccer follows the same appeals and grievance procedures as Us Youth Soccer. These procedures will be available soon on the MYSA website. <http://www.mayouthsoccer.org>
- Registration status (5 part process) - Only 4 towns out of 20 were fully compliant as of 9/12/18 so that means 20% of our league is doing what the need to legally play. Final payments are due on October 26, 2018.
Once registered with the town the players are cover for insurance.
One contact from each town needs to complete the protecting young player's sexual abuse training. If you need the link please email Dana Santilli. There is a small fee for this training.
- MTOC fees increasing to \$550/team - This fee will be spread out between the teams.

• **Fall Season**
